

Review of the Constitution of Irish Squash Federation.

In order to enable patrons who donate funds to Squash Ireland to avail of tax relief on donations we need to get a sporting tax exemption number from the Revenue. The revenue reviewed our Constitution and requested that in order for our application for a sporting tax exemption to be considered favourably we need to make changes to the constitution.

The revenue recommended the following changes, which are now being presented for approval:

1. The name of the company to contain the letters CLG, CLG stands for Company Limited by Guarantee. Irish Squash Federation is already a CLG.
2. The term Association, when it refers to Irish Squash to be replaced with Company throughout the document.
3. The following paragraphs have been moved

4. To include the revenue standard clauses relating to;
 - a. Income & Property
 - b. Winding-up
 - c. Additions, alterations or amendments
 - d. Keeping of Accounts

These clauses in the document were replaced with the Revenue standard clauses.

5. Additional clauses included in the powers relating to
 - a. investment of surplus funds
 - b. pensions for employees
 - c. setting a minimum of 3 directors.
